Lambton Park consists of over 1,000 acres of spectacular natural landscape with a remarkable history that dates back to the 11th century.

As the ancestral home of the Earls of Durham, the park has remained inaccessible to the public for most of its history. However, as part of a major regeneration, much of this green expanse has been opened up to the public, allowing everyone to enjoy its magical charm and verdant beauty.











With such a variety of landscapes, there is always something to enjoy. Catch a glimpse of a kingfisher on the bank of the River Wear; take some time to reflect at one of the many glass-like ponds and lakes; or find the perfect spot to relax in extensive parkland, admiring picturesque views over pastureland where resident sheep, cattle and horses graze lazily.

There are also extensive areas of ancient woodland to explore, which play home to a wide range of flora and fauna. Look out for bird life as you roam through dappled light beneath the canopy, relishing the pastel colours and distinctive smells of bluebells, daffodils and wild garlic. Such natural beauty is perfectly complemented by a number of interesting architectural landmarks around the park. Whether it's the grandeur of the aforementioned castle, the distinctive Castle Stables or the single arch of Lamb Bridge, so named for the unique carved stone lambs on each corner.

# Market town charm

Hedworths Green is conveniently located a five-minute drive from Chester-le-Street. This charming market town plays home to a choice of major supermarkets, banks, pharmacies and other essentials, such as doctors and dental surgeries.

There is also a great choice of local schools, with several primary and secondary options all within 10 minutes by road.







In the historic town centre you will find high street favourites, unique independents and regular town markets selling various goods and fresh produce. There are also plenty of pubs, cafés and restaurants - the closest of which is within walking distance of Hedworths Green.

Chester-le-Street Leisure Centre is located a six-minute drive away and features a swimming pool, gym and fitness classes. Alternatively, the town's Golf Club offers 18 holes and beautiful scenery, while the local amateur rowing club always welcomes new members. If you prefer to spectate, the Riverside cricket ground is a five-minute drive away and has hosted several international matches. The ground also holds regular concerts from a long list of world-class acts.

There's plenty of outdoor fun to be had at Nearby Riverside Park, which comprises gardens, scenic walks and a play area, while Lumley Castle and Gardens make a wonderful day out.

# BREATHING THE FRESH SEA AIR

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A little further afield, you could be breathing the fresh sea air on Seaham Beach within 20 minutes by car, while the North Pennines are around half-an-hour away.

For more excitement, it's a 15-minute drive to Durham's historic streets, packed with independent boutiques. Newcastle's unique city centre is also easily reached, along with the world-class shopping on offer at Metrocentre in Gateshead - both around 20 minutes by road.

All this is easily reached via great local transport links. The A1 makes road travel simple, passing nearby as it carves a

continuous line all the way from London to Edinburgh. Rail links are also strong, with Chester-le-Street Station sitting on the TransPennine Express line between Newcastle and Liverpool Lime Street.

Trains to Newcastle take around 10 minutes and from here, it is possible to be in Edinburgh in 86 minutes and London as little as two-and-a-half hours.

For air travel, Newcastle international airport is a 23-minute drive away and offers flights to destinations worldwide.
