A great mix of characterful independent businesses and national high-street favourites can cater for most needs, especially when combined with the farmers' market, where you can pick up the freshest local produce.

There are plenty of ways to stay entertained on your doorstep, with Desborough Theatre offering a packed schedule of drama, music and comedy and the multi-screen cinema showing all the latest blockbusters. Socialising is also made easy, with countless pubs bars and restaurants to be found in the town, along with the newly regenerated Waterside area, which is just around the corner.

Alternatively, travel a little further afield to sample one of the many Michelin Starred restaurants in the surrounding area, such as Tom Kerridge's Hand & Flowers in Marlow or Heston Blumenthal's The Fat Duck in Bray.

If you're looking for history and culture, visit Maidenhead's Heritage Centre and Museum before exploring the town's many landmarks and beautiful open spaces. Kidwell Park is one such open space





and forms a real community hub. In addition to plenty of open grassy areas, you can find a playground, sports courts and a skatepark. The park is also home to a number of events throughout the year, including the much-loved Maidenhead Festival, where you can enjoy music, food and a funfair.

Alternatively, it's an 11-minute walk to the banks of the Thames which make the perfect place for a leisurely stroll by the water. Head north to explore Boulters Lock and the beautiful Ray Mill Island, admiring narrowboats and looking out for birdlife along the way. From here, it's also possible to connect with Clivedon Woodlands, which you can follow all the way to the glorious National Trust Clivedon house and gardens.

For those who like to stay active, Maidenhead offers lots of options. Aside from the brand-new Braywick Leisure Centre, with a swimming pool and gym, there are many opportunities to pursue water sports locally. Head over to Taplow Lakeside or Bray Lake for open-water swimming, wakeboarding, canoeing, paddle boarding, windsurfing and more. Alternatively, Maidenhead Sailing Club at nearby Summerleaze Lake offers year-round sailing and paddle sports.

ENJOY OUTSTANDING TRANSPORT LINKS BY ROAD, RAIL AND AIR

Cooper Square benefits from excellent travel connections by road and rail that offer convenient access to surrounding towns and cities. Marlow and Windsor are only 16 minutes away by road, and you can be in High Wycombe, Slough and Bracknell in just over 20 minutes. Alternatively, the A404 connects to the M4 which puts Heathrow Airport within 25 minutes and takes you to the world-class shopping, entertainment and excitement of central London in as little as an hour. For rail travel, Maidenhead Station is an 11-minute walk away and operates fast services to Reading in less than 15 minutes, direct services to London Paddington in under 20 minutes and a brand-new Crossrail connection that takes you straight through the heart of the city. The result is a perfect location for both commuters and day-trippers alike.
